Remove as much glue as possible with a dull knife or spatula. Wipe the surface with a cloth or sponge dipped in warm sudsy water. Rinse well and wipe dry.

Once the adhesive has softened, use a non-metal plastic scraper or credit card to remove it, then wipe away any remaining residue with a cloth dampened in warm soapy water.
